VACCINATIONS POLICY

New Jersey state law requires that all students attending post-secondary institutions in New Jersey show proof of immunization for measles, mumps, rubella and hepatitis. This law requires all students born after 1956, who are matriculated in a degree program, and who did not attend an elementary or secondary school in New Jersey, to provide the institution with a record of immunization.

In addition to meeting the above requirements, all students intending to reside in Rabbinical College of America's dormitory facility must submit evidence of immunization for meningitis from within five years of the date of enrollment at the Rabbinical College of America.
